the Bachelor of Musi c (Musi c Performance) course at the Mel bourne Conserv atorium of Musi c and has been a member of Opera Scholars Australia since 2022.

N i ck also brings experi ence as a liturgi cal can tor to hi s role, having sung previously at St An thony's Shrine, Hawthorn and St Joan of Arc Church, Brighton.
